Key trends: summary of pass rates

- Across the board, a higher percentage of test candidates who chose to have a driving instructor passed, as compared with candidates who chose to test solo.
- There was a difference in pass rates between **manual** candidates who chose to test with a driving instructor present (between 82 and 83 per cent) as compared with those who chose to test solo (between 77 and 80 per cent).
- There was a more pronounced difference in pass rates between **automatic** drivers who chose to have an instructor present (between 74 to 82 per cent) and those who tested solo (between 69 and 74 per cent).
