Key trends: summary of pass rates

- Across the board, a higher percentage of test candidates who chose to have a driving instructor passed, as compared with candidates who chose to test solo.
- There was a difference in pass rates between manual candidates who chose to test with a driving instructor present (between 82 and 83 per cent) as compared with those who chose to test solo (between 77 and 80 per cent).
- There was a more pronounced difference in pass rates between automatic drivers
 who chose to have an instructor present (between 74 to 82 per cent) and those who tested
 solo (between 69 and 74 per cent).
